My only complaint is the 4CIG which a complete mess. the guard buzzer is the High horn. anyways, this pack gets a.. A perfect addition for routes that have third rail electrification and the scenarios that came with this pack are good. The Class 421 "CIG" unit doesn't have a passenger view whereas the Class 416 does. The pack hasn't given me the "wow" factor but it is good enough to make your own scenarios.. An essential add on if your thing is Southern Region British Rail, I find the GUVs particularly useful. The emus drive well as do the class 33 ond 09 locos.

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This pack also features my favourite non Western loco the class 73 electro-diesel. If you're not a BR Southern fan then this pack probably isn't for you.. I bought this pack wanting more BR blue stock and expected it to be diesels, kinda stepped into a mine here, realising three of the locos are meant for third rail routes, from which i own only the Isle of Wight. Decided to try and build my own naive fictitious route for them xD Other than that, the pack seems quite well done, I didn't yet notice much difference between the class 09 and RSC's class 08, but I can't say a bad word about it. I don't know what to say about the EMU's, they look good but I'm not a big fan of this kind of stock, so I can't say much. I really like the hybrid engine though, it's a really unusual and fun vehicle to drive, seems really well done to me too. The diesel loco is a good addition to the br blue collection in general, it has nice controls, sounds, the model is highly detailed just as others, glad to have something else to drive from that era than the basic kuju stock. The pack was also very cheap on sale.. My opinion for the rolling stock is as follows Class 09: Another Class 08 Rehash, nothing really to say. Class 33: I can't tell on this one (At the time of this review, I do not have the 33 Packs), it's ok, to say the LEAST. Class 73: Ok, Thank GOD they didn't make any horrible sounds for this. Instead they used their Gatwick 73 Sounds, which are good. Class 416: 415 Sounds, but they're ok. Class 421: Ok, this is a utter joke. AWS doesn't work half the time, very crappy sounds, horrible horn. If i'm not mistaken, didn't only the 4CEP's and the 4VEP's operate on this route? The LEAST I can say about this is the BR Blue/Grey livery is somewhat OK, but not that good. OBA: Reused directly from the S&C GUV: This one's nice. I wish they modelled it to where you can open the doors though. Overall, I give this a 6/17. Now lets hope AP updates their 421/422/423 Soundpack to fix that mess of a CIG.. Very very nice pack except the CIG is erroneous for the Chatham Main Line as only CEPs with or without MLV's worked to the coast from Victoria and the only time you would have seen a CIG is if it was passing over head at Penge East.. This is absolutely rubbish. I've tried enough to know: 4VEP 1) Call guard has a horrible sound - same as the high horn actually 2) Speedometer is really really bad 3) None of the buttons work in the cab 4) No such thing as headlights apparently 5) No passenger view There's one positive - the brush motors. I was using this for just a minute when I've ahd enough. Lucky enough I bought it in a twin pack. DO NOT BUY.. THE BLUE ELECTRIC PACK SEEMS TO BE A WELL MADE PROJECT. I AVEN'T GOTTEN TO PLAY ALLOT OF THIS ONE YET, BUT LEARNING DIFFERENT THINGS. I WISH YOU CAN BE ABLE TO MIX THE CARS ONTO THE ENGINES, I HAVENT LEARN IF YOU CAN CONNECT TO THE CARS OR UNCONNECT THAT I HAVEN'T SEEN YET. BUT I HAVE LEARN THAT YOU CAN EDIT CARS TO THE ENGINES WHICH IS REAL NICE TOOL. I WISH THE WAS MORE ROUTES AND SENARENOS TO CAN PUT TO THE TRAINS TO RUN, AND IF THEIR IS I'D LIKE SOMEONE DIRECT ME TO THEM ON A LINK I CAN CLICK ON.
